Hope Dealer is an in-person training that will provide participants the opportunity to:

- Better understand the complexity of the youth population through data trends.
- Learn the interplay of systems on a youth's journey through life (schools, justice system, treatment providers).
- Learn skills to instill hope in our youth and to mitigate potential harm to the youth involved in multiple systems.

The session will be led by **Hasan Davis, J.D.**, who has been Commissioner of Juvenile Justice for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Vice Chair of the Federal Advisory Committee on Juvenile Justice, and an organizational consultant. Mr. Davis shares his journey through the education, justice, and social service systems illustrating how these systems often failed to provide him the support he needed to be successful. Luckily on his journey, Mr. Davis encountered system outliers and resisters, whom he affectionately calls "hope dealers," that found a way to engage, encourage and empower him. With their support, he was able to transcend his mounting list of "failures" and become the champion for youth that he is today.

While optional, this training provides an opportunity to broaden your knowledge on serving youth who are navigating multiple systems with complex health needs. Together we can learn how to serve and empower the youth that are tomorrow's future.
