*\*Programs marked with asterisks integrate holistic approaches to caring for patients with substance use disorder (SUD), opioid use disorder, and stimulant use disorder into the curriculums. They are recommended for participants interested in the Indiana State Loan Repayment Plan (IN-SLRP).*

*The IN-SLRP is a workforce retention program providing student loan repayment to healthcare professionals who provide primary care, mental, and dental healthcare services in federally designated health professional shortage areas in Indiana. IN-SLRP participants can receive up to \$20,000 to repay outstanding loans in exchange for two years of service and can reapply for an additional two years of service to receive an additional \$20,000. IN-SLRP participants are required to complete an entire ECHO program to improve the quality of care provided to underserved populations.
