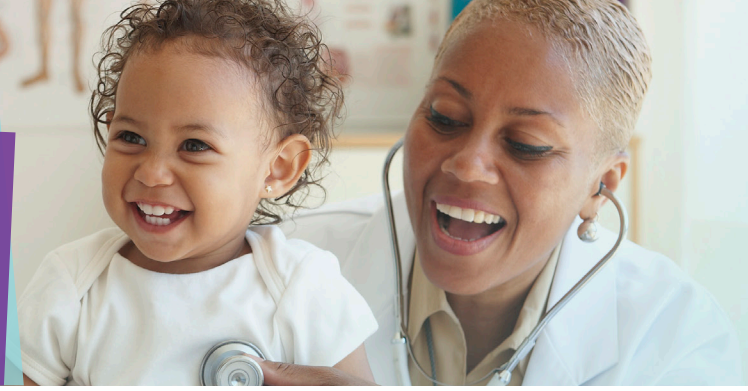

Our Model

CareSource is a health insurance company focused primarily on public programs including Medicaid, Medicare Advantage, Dual Eligible and the Health Insurance Marketplace. While others in health care focus on maximizing profits, CareSource puts people before profit. Our best-in-class administrative cost ratio allows us to enrich our benefits and invest more in the care of our more than 1.8 million members. We partner with states and the federal government to increase quality, decrease costs and ensure our members have easy, affordable access to health care.

Highlights of our business model include:

- Low administrative costs around six percent (compared to 10 to 13 percent nationally)
- 90 percent of revenue spent on member care
- More than 200,000 health partners and more than 712 hospitals in our networks

Our Services

CareSource has programs to improve the health and well-being of our members across all markets and products. The programs we offer may vary between markets.

Medicaid

Health coverage for low income people, families and children, pregnant women, the elderly, people with disabilities and those receiving home and community-based services (HCBS). Medicaid and Medicaid Expansion programs vary by state.

Health Insurance Marketplace

Qualified health plans offered through the Health Insurance Marketplace providing low-cost comprehensive coverage for individuals and families.

Dual Eligible/MyCare Ohio

Primary, acute, behavioral health and long-term care services for those who are dually eligible for Medicaid and Medicare.

Medicare Advantage

Plans that provide all of the Medicare benefits for doctors and hospital coverage (Parts A & B), combined with Medicare prescription drug benefits (Part D).

CareSource Foundation

Since its 2006 inception, the CareSource Foundation has awarded more than \$14.5 million in grants to nonprofit organizations in our service area. Areas of focus include critical health trends and community health concerns such as childhood obesity and issues of the uninsured.
