Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) is a medication that people at risk for human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) acquisition can take to reduce their chances of getting HIV through sex and/or injection drug use.

NPIN is a web-based information and resource platform connecting public health partners through collaborative communication and innovative technology solutions for HIV, viral hepatitis, sexually transmitted diseases (STDs), tuberculosis, and adolescent and school health. NPIN maintains a searchable database of information submitted to the CDC NPIN by the testing center or provider organization. Information entered into the NPIN database powers tools such as the [GetTested](#) testing locator utility and the [PrEP Locator](#) tool.
