Subject: Chiropractic Benefit for Members Increased to 18 Visits

Effective: June 1, 2012

Starting June 1, 2012, CareSource members age 21 and older will be eligible to receive 18 chiropractic visits per year; an increase from the previous benefit of five chiropractic visits.

This replaces the previous 2009 Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) Executive Order 2009-22, that chiropractic services are no longer payable for beneficiaries age 21 and older. At that time, CareSource made the business decision to continue allowing members to receive five chiropractic visits.

Now, the State of Michigan has directed that this benefit be reinstated for all eligible Medicaid members. Reimbursement for services will be at the standard Fee-For-Service Medicaid rates.

No Referral or Prior Authorization Needed

CareSource members can see any participating chiropractor without a referral or prior authorization. There are no co-pays for this benefit.
